Lucia Nogueira London

The late Brazilian artist Lucia Nogueira devised playful installations that exposed the fragility of life. Parodying the Don't Touch rule in museums and galleries, her wondrous exhibition at The Anthony Reynolds Gallery in 1995 had visitors picking their way through shards of glass and avoiding
